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## **You have been booked to have an Arterial Upper Limb study at Vascular West**

Your doctor has asked for an arterial study. The test gives us important information about the arteries in your arm and shoulder.

An arterial study is an ultrasound test of the upper arm and shoulder arteries specifically to check for blockages and narrowing. A full study can take up to 45 minutes to perform. You will be asked to lie flat and an ultrasound probe and gel will be applied to your arm. Ultrasound used for the purpose of diagnostic values is completely harmless, however if you are or may be pregnant please let the sonographer know prior to the test. Ultrasound is also completely painless although probe pressure may cause some minor discomfort.

The sonographer will usually commence in your wrist and move up the arm and shoulder looking for abnormalities in the arterial blood flow. You may be asked to roll onto your side at times. The sonographer will take all appropriate measurements and document any other abnormalities. A report will be completed by the sonographer and finalised by one of our vascular surgeons. This will then be sent to your referring doctor and/or GP within 48 hours.
